

CSS/LULAC LEGALIZATION AND LIFE ACT ADJUSTMENT
FORM TO GATHER INFORMATION FOR THIRD PARTY
DECLARATIONS

This form should be filled out to gather information about persons who will sign declarations in support of LIFE Act or CSS/LULAC Settlement Legalization applications,

Use this form to gather information needed to supplement existing evidence, or to respond to a Notice of Intent to Deny, or to file additional declarations with an appeal from a final denial (new evidence CAN be submitted as part of an appeal of a denial under the LIFE Act).

For CSS and LULAC/Newman Settlement applications, use this form to gather information that will then be used to prepare declarations in support of applications.

Information should be gathered from people who know the applicant in his or her home country (cousins, uncles, aunts, parents, brothers, sisters, friends, etc.), or who are living in the United States.

The main point of the LIFE Act declarations is to provide evidence that the applicant resided continuously and unlawfully in the United States from before 1982 to May 1988.

The main point of the CSS/LULAC legalization declarations is to provide evidence that the applicant resided continuously and unlawfully in the United States from before 1982 to the date on which they were turned away by the INS during the amnesty application period.

The applicant should gather the information requested on this form, and then return the form to the attorney or legal assistant who will prepare the declarations for the applicant.

Each applicant should receive about 12 copies of this form so they can gather information for approximately 12 declarations (from the home country and from within the U.S.)

The applicant should be as complete as possible in filling out this form.
